No work will be released before close of show.

For works left **beyond 12:00pm on Monday, May 26,** the artist may be charged \$25.00 plus a storage fee. **If you cannot pick up your work on time, it is your responsibility to make arrangements with someone to pick it up for you.** Although great care is always used when handling art work, neither WACG nor the Art Museum will be responsible for damage or loss of your work if left beyond the pick up date.

Awards: Over \$2,000.00 will be awarded including the \$800.00 **Rebecca Bryan Best in Show Award.**

The Museum and WACG will share a 30% commission on all sales which occur during the exhibition..

To enter: Photos will be required for this show. No slides. Detach & mail completed Entry Form & Notification Form with \$25.00 Entry Fee & photos to: WACG Juried Show PO Box 1595 Myrtle Beach, SC 29578.
Photos must be no larger than 4 X 6 inches. Any photo larger than 4 X 6 inches cannot be accepted. Please do not send computer CD's

Preferably, 2D work should be photographed before framing. All work should be photographed with no background or a neutral and uncluttered background. Submitted work must be exactly the same as depicted in its entirety in the photos. (Do not crop parts of the work out of the photo). No substitutions for accepted entries will be allowed. Up to three entries per artist. Acceptable forms of art include painting, drawing, graphics, photography, mixed media, fiber, textile, sculpture, original ceramics and hand crafted jewelry. Entries must be original & executed by the artist within the past two years and not previously shown at a WACG Show or at the Art Museum. For 2D work, only one photo per piece is necessary. For 3D work you may submit up to two photos per piece.
Works depicting recognizable faces or figures must be accompanied by a signed model release. Any work created in a class or with the help of an instructor is not eligible for entry. All work must be the sole original creation of the artist. Print all information on back of photo (title, medium, artist's name). All accepted photos and bio's will be retained and displayed in an exhibition book during the show.
Size Limits:
2D: the framed size must not exceed 50 inches in width or height. and must be securely framed and WIRED on the back for hanging. Gallery wrap canvas will be allowed unframed. Corner brackets and clip mountings will not be accepted.
3D: the finished size may not exceed 95" high and/or 72" in width or depth and must be fully equipped for hanging and/or installation (if free standing). Sculpture weight may not exceed 100 pounds per sq. foot of base area. Artist will be totally responsible for prearranged handling of work over 50 lb.

Instructions for Accepted Artists:

Upon acceptance of your work into the show, you will receive a notice and a very important form from the Art Museum concerning insurance information. Review, fill in, sign and return the form **immediately** to: **The Art Museum, 3100 Ocean Blvd, Myrtle Beach, SC 29577, or fax to the Art Museum: 843-238-2910. Do not send insurance forms to WACG.**

Failure to return the Insurance Form to **The Art Museum** by **April 18** will result in elimination from the show.

All information on the Insurance Form must be exactly the same, (title, size, price) as you put on the Entry Form. (Remember to make a copy of your entry form and keep for reference)

Please provide a short, one page Artist Bio & send in with the insurance form.

Accepted art work must be delivered to the Museum on April 28, (Monday) between 9am and 2pm (All work must be at the Museum by 2pm)

Juror

Sandra Rupp, Director of the Hampton III Art Gallery Ltd., in Taylors, SC, just outside of Greenville, will be the Juror/Judge for the 11th Annual Juried Show. Hampton III Gallery was founded and partially owned by her father, Richard Rupp in 1970. The gallery boasts exhibits including some of the most renowned artists in and outside the Carolinas such as: John Acorn, Darell Koons and Leo Twiggs to name a few of the more than 30 professional, award winning artists represented.

Sandra Rupp, as Director for Hampton III Gallery, is responsible for overseeing the quality of the paintings and artists exhibited by the gallery. She also serves as a consultant to private or corporate institutions. There will be a gallery talk and walk through by Ms. Rupp following the awards presentation.
