WACG APRIL MEETING

WACG will meet on April 17 at The Art Museum at 10:15 am.

The program for this meeting will be a critique by noted artist **Alex Powers**. Bring one or two recently finished works or something you are currently working on (in any media) to have critiqued. Depending on how many bring art, you may be able to have more than one piece of art critiqued. Don't miss this chance to have a professional opinion and advice about your work. This program will be sponsored by the South Carolina Watercolor Society.

2010 Juried Exhibit

Seventy pieces of art have been juried into the WACG Juried Exhibit at The Art Museum by Judge John Acorn. That is the maximum number of pieces which can be accommodated for the space at the museum using both downstairs galleries provided for our exhibit by the art museum.

The accepted works cover various media and most are two dimensional. We did not receive enough 3D work for a 3D category this year so awards will be presented over all.

If your work was accepted into the exhibit, please don't forget to bring a short, one page Bio (who your are & what you wish to say about your work) for the display book. You may send it to the museum with your Signage & Loan Agreement or bring it with you on April 26 when you deliver your work to the museum.

For those of you who may not understand the process for our Juried Exhibit here is a brief explanation. The show is chosen (Juried) by a qualified professional in the field of art who is usually recommended by The Art Museum staff. He/she pics the exhibit from photos of work entered by the artists and crafters. The photos are set up in a presentation album with only the title, media and size of each piece provided. No artists' names are included. The entries are sent to the Judge, who makes his/her choices and sends the album back at which time the artists are notified of acceptance/rejection. After the exhibit is hung, the judge then comes in and makes final judgments from the actual work.

No one from the museum or from WACG has any influence on who does or does not get into the exhibit; however, they reserve the right to remove or exclude any work not conforming to the stated guidelines set out in the Prospectus or deemed inappropriate for the exhibit.

Awards for the Juried show are provided in part by donations from the public. We welcome and depend on this support to help provide awards for our artists. All donations are state and federal tax deductible and our SC Charitable Organization number is **3262**.

The awards this year will be as follows:

Best In Show - Rebecca Bryan Award, First, Second and Third Place, 10 Honorable Mentions and some possible memorial awards sponsored by various persons.
