• WACG 2011 Juried Exhibit

The dates for the 2011 Juried Exhibit at The Art Museum will be May 5th - 25th. The entry photos are now in the hands of our Judge, Cara-lin Getty. As soon as we have them back (with her choices) and they have been processed, we will notify all who entered (by regular mail) whether or not your work was chosen for the show. If your work was selected, you will also receive an important document from the museum pertaining to required insurance information. It is mandatory that this document is sent back to the museum by the date indicated (refer to your prospectus). No work may be hung by the museum without this information. If you did not keep a copy of your prospectus with all the needed information about the show schedule, etc., go to our web site and download another copy. If your work was not selected for the exhibit, please don't be discouraged. Only a certain number of pieces can be accommodated by the space at the museum so it does not mean your work is inferior in any way. There will always be another exhibit!

The exhibit will be hung by Kay Teer, but if you would like to help with check-in on Monday, May 2nd, Email Phyllis: pafadunn@aol.com. We will only need 3 or 4 people.

It has been called to my attention that a few people didn't get a Prospectus for this show. Always check you Emails carefully as most of you are now receiving newsletters and other postings by Email. It is very easy to overlook or accidentally delete an important Email since we all get so many from so many different sources, some of which are not welcome and/or are from unknown people. If you are uncertain about the source of a received Email, it is OK to go ahead and open it without harm or risk to your identity or computer. Once you have opened it and checked it out you can then delete it or send it to your "Spam" folder if it is not something you wish to receive. NEVER CLICK ON A LINK in an Email from someone you don't know, however, and NEVER click on "unsubscribe". Doing that is where you put yourself at risk and "unsubscribing" will only open you up to even more unwanted Email. After opening the Email, delete it and/or mark it as Spam if you don't know the sender.

For a safer and foolproof alternative, both our newsletters and show entry forms are now on our web site - **www.wacg.org**. If you feel you have missed something, an occasional visit to our web site should take care of it since both newsletters and show entry forms can be downloaded and printed out from there. So..visit our web site once a week or so (which you should be doing anyway) and that should keep you up to date with all Guild activities. If you would like more information and/or tips about Spam, just Google "how to handle spam" and you will get lots of information from many sources. Hope this is helpful.
