2010 WACG Juried Exhibit

This will be the 13th Annual Juried Exhibit sponsored by WACG and will again be presented at The Art Museum located at 3100 South Ocean Blvd. near the entrance to the old air force base.

The juror/judge for the exhibit will be **John Acorn**. Mr. Acorn is a prolific sculptor living in Pendleton SC. He is retired from Clemson University where he taught for 36 years, serving as Head of the Department of Visual Arts and History for more than 20 years. He has exhibited widely throughout the Southeast, and his works are in numerous public, private and museum collections. In 1998, Mr. Acorn received the Elizabeth O'Neill Verner Award, the South Carolina Arts Commission's most prestigious honor bestowed in recognition of an artist's commitment to furthering arts in the State. Mr. Acorn is still an active working artist and is currently part of an exhibit presented at The Art Museum called "Milestones: Celebrating 70 and Beyond".
