## Newsletter (from the Editor)

It seems that a few people are still having trouble receiving the newsletter by Email. Some are being returned to me as "undeliverable" for various reasons even though I am sure I am using an accurate Email address. I am not a computer expert, but have been told that when sending out group Emails, the recipient's system may interpret it as spam and block it out. This occurs when the recipient systems' security settings are set too high and are blocking some incoming Email, interpreting it as spam. You may want to check your security settings and set them to medium security if you feel you are missing some of your legitimate incoming mail. The newsletter will always be identified by "WACG Newsletter" as "Subject" so you can recognize it.

You can adjust your security settings however you feel most comfortable, including the option to set it so that almost all spam will be identified and delivered to your Spam Folder (instead of being deleted). Be sure to check your Spam Folder every few days to make sure wanted email (your newsletter) was not accidentally delivered there. You can get to your security settings if you are using AOL by clicking "settings" (found in the upper right corner of your incoming mail screen). Other systems should be similar - you may need to contact your Email provider or check the "help" manual which is usually found online.

I hope I haven't totally confused you or given you bad information. I use a Mac so if any of you PC computer "gurus" out there have other suggestions, as to how to remedy this situation, please let me know and I will pass it on. (Phyllis - [pafadunn@aol.com](mailto:pafadunn@aol.com))
