Booth size is 10 x 10 and you are required to provide a tent. Booth fee is \$40. A 50% discount is provided to all active members of any Horry County arts organization. Photos of your art may be required if organizers are not familiar with your work.

EQUINOX is an event on the Artists of the Tobacco Trail Spring Event Schedule. This is a new arts initiative supported by South Carolina Parks, Recreation & Tourism to promote artisans and artists in this twelve county region of South Carolina. The goal of this group is to bring together artists, artisans and retailers for the benefit of marketing, tourism, education and shared resources. The group will jointly participate and promote shows throughout the region.

EQUINOX is also a part of Horry County Arts & Cultural Councils Fabulous Fifties, a week-long celebration and fund raiser for the arts.

We still have a few spaces available for just \$20. to members of WACG. Also, you may share a booth this year. We already have 50 artists and musicians participating and this is the kick off for the HCACC Fabulous 50's Festival.
