### WACG Annual Juried Exhibit

The 13th Annual Juried Exhibit at The Art Museum is now in place with awards presented at a lovely reception on April 29th by Judge John Acorn. Our only regret is that all our entering artists could not be represented; but such is the nature of a juried exhibit especially when there is a limit on how many pieces can physically be displayed in the space provided.

There is great variety in the seventy pieces Mr. Acorn juried in, with many mediums including oils, watercolors, pen and ink, colored pencil, mixed media and great photographs including some with unusual treatments. In addition, although we did not receive very many 3 dimensional pieces we do have a few including wood carvings, and a relief sculpture. There were also three very interesting fabric/textile pieces resulting in a collection of styles and mediums which represent the excellent talents of area artists. If you have not yet seen the exhibit, be sure to go by and check it out. The exhibit will close on May 27th.
