WACG Member's Only Judged Exhibit

Lots of entries are coming in for the upcoming Guild art exhibit which will be at Springmaid Beach Resort. The deadline for entry is October 15, so if you haven't entered yet, be sure to get it to us by then.

We now have a confirmed Judge for the show. The judge will be Robin Salmon, Vice President for Collections and Curator of Sculpture at Brookgreen Gardens. Ms. Salmon, a native of South Carolina, has been on the staff of Brookgreen Gardens since 1975. She has degrees in history and art history from the University of South Carolina, and is a graduate of the Museum Management Institute of the American Federation of Arts and the J. Paul Getty Trust held at the University of California-Berkeley. She is the author and co-author of several books and has written numerous essays and articles.

If we are very lucky, Ms. Salmon may be accompanied by noted sculptor, **John Sisko**, who will be in the area that week. If you would like to know more about John Sisko just put his name in a Google or other search engine.

Sometimes we do not receive enough three dimensional works to create an awards category in our exhibits, especially when we have Professional and Nonprofessional divisions. If we do not have enough three dimensional pieces for awards in both Professional and Nonprofessional categories, the 3D pieces will have to be included with the two dimensional works. We would like to encourage all our fine sculptors and creators of three dimensional work (as well as our fine two dimensional artists) to enter the show. This is an unusual opportunity to have your work looked at and judged by very experienced and knowledgeable professionals both of whom are experts on all forms of art.

We will take in the artwork and set up the exhibit on November 3rd in the large room located just across the street from the Springmaid offices which are located on the right just behind The Art Museum. The official opening will be on November 4th at 10 AM, with the awards reception that evening from 6 to 7:30 PM. A show schedule will be posted when you deliver your work on November 3rd.
